
Moreau stating that he expects to sail for France sometime during the coming week. "Goat" is now acting as French interpreter for the 10th Engineering Corps.

IF ANYONE HAS AS GOOD OR BETTER TRUE FISH STORY WE WOULD LIKE TO HAVE IT.



SOME TIME AGO



1,656,678 MEN ENLISTED ON THE NORTH-ERN SIDE.

1,082,119 MEN ENLISTED ON THE SOUTH-ERN SIDE.

THE COST TO THE NORTH WAS ABOUT THREE BILLION DOLLARS.

THE SOUTH SPENT ABOUT \$27,000,000 IN GOLD, WHICH WAS ALL THEY COULD GET. THEY ALSO SPENT A LARGE AMOUNT IN CURRENCY, COTTON AND TOBACCO. THEIR CURRENCY REACHED MORE THAN A BILLION DOLLARS.

THE COST OF THE WAR WAS ABOUT FIFTEEN HUNDRED DOLLARS PER MINUTE FOR THE ENTIRE FOUR YEARS.

THE FIRST DRAFT BILL THE UNITED STATES EVER HAD WAS PASSED DURING THE CIVIL WAR, AND WAS FIERCELY RESISTED.
